We realize that you may have questions about what you can expect when you arrive on Sunday morning to drop off your child in one of our Nursery classrooms. I have tried to answer some of your questions below. If you have additional questions, please do not hesitate to email me or call.

Work: 864-653-3045

Check-In : Check-in will be very similar. When you arrive on Sunday morning please walk to one of three check-in locations in the foyer as you approach our Children's hallway.

Drop Off & Pick up: We ask that if possible only one parent or guardian walk back to drop off/pick up children in their designated classroom. We realize that this may be a challenge for those with multiple children and we are willing to accommodate. Our goal is to try and minimize the amount of traffic walking up and down our hallway.

Drop Off Time: We are asking that all children be dropped off no sooner than 15 minutes prior to the start of each service.

In The Classroom: Our nursery classrooms will be limited in size. Each room will max out at 10 children to accommodate for volunteers and optimal spacing to encourage social distancing. Volunteers will be required to wear masks, wash hands upon arrival, wear gloves when changing diapers or dispersing any consumable items (snack or bottle).

Temperature Checks: Volunteers will be asked to check their temperatures upon arrival. We will also take the temperature of your child before allowing them to enter into one of our classroom spaces. Anyone with a temperature of 100.4 or above will be asked not to enter.

Snacks: Due to our shortened services we are not planning to serve a snack to children. We will monitor this and will adjust if we feel like we can do so safely.

Lessons and Crafts: We will continue to work through our Gospel project material that does a great job helping us teach children the narrative of scripture and exalting Christ as savior. We will continue with crafts. Each class will have their own supply box with resources to minimize resources passing through multiple hands at different services.

We are excited to begin opening our Nursery spaces and we hope to be able to progress in opening Kids Worship shortly after. We want to do all we reasonably can to create a safe place for your kids to be cared for and to grow in the Lord while you worship.
