We realize that you may have questions about what you can expect when you drop your child off at Kid's Connection this Sunday. I have tried to answer some of them below. If you still have questions, please do not hesitate to email me or call.

**Check-In/Temperature Checks** : All Children will check-in and print out their security tags in the foyer of the church. As you walk into the foyer please stop and have your child's temperature checked before getting a security sticker. Temperatures must be below 100.4 to check into a classroom. Once your child has received their security sticker you may walk them to their appropriate classroom.

**0-1st Grade** - Located on the Kid's hall next to the sanctuary

**2nd-5th Grade** - Located in the Equipping Center.

**\*4th&5th Grade** are to be dropped off in their classroom, and **picked up from the sanctuary** at the close of the night

**Drop Off & Pick up:** We ask that if possible only one parent or guardian walk back to drop off/pick up children in their designated classroom. We realize that this may be a challenge for those with multiple children and we are willing to accommodate. Our goal is to try and minimize the amount of traffic walking up and down our hallway.

**Drop Off Time:** We are asking that all children be checked-in no sooner than 15 minutes prior to the start of Kid's Connection.

**In The Classroom:** Kids will start off in their classroom before starting their next activity.

**Dinner:** We have made an intentional effort to provide meals for kids that we can serve safely trying to minimize any transference of germs. We have staggered eating times to minimize the number of kids in the foyer at one time. We have also limited the number of people allowed at each round table to 5 to allow for more space in between.

**Lessons and Crafts:** We will continue to work through our Gospel project material that does a great job helping us teach children the narrative of scripture and exalting Christ as savior. We

Please note that for your child to attend Kids Connection this year you must have registered ahead of time. All our volunteers are required to wear masks, and we encourage your children (3 years and above) to wear masks though they are not required to.
