

How to:

Share the Gospel

Trainer's Guide

"For I am not ashamed of the gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes, to the Jew first and also to the Greek."

Romans 1:16 ESV

This is a short guide that explains important steps and tips for equipping a group of people to be able to share the Gospel with others.

Steps for training others:

Tips

1

Prepare by practicing the Gospel yourself before your group meets. Bring any supplies you may need (e.g., laptop/TV for watching the video, dry erase board/paper for you to write on, paper and pens for your small group members).

2

Pray. Begin the training with prayer. Ask God for clarity, confidence, and conviction to share the Gospel as a result of this training.

3

Watch. As a group, watch the online training video linked at the bottom of this document for one of the Gospel sharing methods (e.g., Bridge Diagram or 3 Circles).

4

Demonstrate by presenting the Gospel to your group. Encourage those you're training to practice drawing the Gospel diagram as they follow along with you.

5

Practice by splitting into pairs. Give about 20-30 minutes for this (or as much time is needed). Have each person present to their partner, receive feedback, and present again implementing the feedback they received.

6

Present. Ask for a volunteer or two to share the Gospel with the group now that they have had time to practice!

7

Plan. Have your group members identify 1-3 people they can pray for and pursue with the Gospel. Encourage them to consider what next steps they can take to pursue them with the Gospel. Then, pray together. You are sent!

- Plan for this activity to take **~60 minutes** in your group from beginning to end.
- Not a group leader but still want to train someone in sharing the Gospel? Feel free to adapt this training for a 1:1 environment!
- If there is someone in your group who is not a believer, try to pair them with yourself or another trusted person so you can answer questions they may have about the Gospel. Avoid putting people like this on the spot to present.
- Approach this time prayerfully and with humility -- people in your group may be saved through hearing the Gospel presented in environments like this!
- Plan a time to share the Gospel as a group in a neighborhood, park, on campus, etc.
